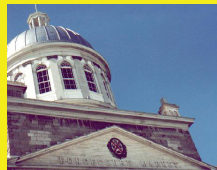

Study English, French or Spanish at M.I.L.A.!

Part-Time: 15 hrs/week

If you work during the day or do not want to study full-time, this program is custom-made for you. Depending on your level, your schedule may be in the morning or in the afternoon, from Monday to Friday. Also, you can choose to attend grammar courses and conversation courses, or conversation courses only.

Regular: 22.5 hrs/week

This program includes Grammar and Conversation (Listening-Speaking-Reading-Writing) courses from Monday to Friday. Depending on your level, you may have classes in the morning or in the afternoon. This program will help you improve your language skills through a variety of activities, games, practical exercises and real life situations.

Intensive: 30 hrs/week

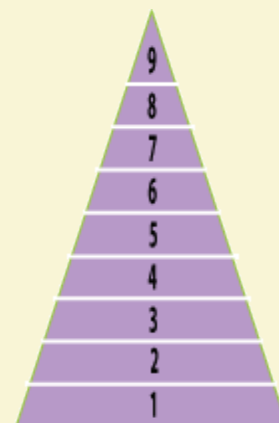
If you wish to improve your language skills much faster or if your stay in Montreal is a short one, this program is meant for you. It combines the regular schedule and a selection of various workshops and electives, such as Idioms, Business English, Introduction to Advertising or Challenges of the New Millenium. The Intensive program is really designed to help you master your new language skills.

Evening: 6 hrs/week

The English, French, and Spanish courses are also offered during the evnings. Depening on your level, the courses my be given on Mondays & Wednesdays, or Tuesday & Thursdays. We offer the same number of levels, but one level lasts 5 weeks (30 hours per level).

LEVELS

Homestay

In a homestay, you will be well taken care of and you will practice your English or French language skills outside the classroom. You'll be surprised how quickly your speaking improves when you're immersed in a familial environment. Even though Canadian host families can be very different from one another, you will see that each single one of them will do their utmost to give you the best experience you can ever have in Montreal.

Each homestay includes:

- A single bedroom fully furnished (including a bed with pillows and bedsheets, a towel and a desk)
- A choice of 2 or 3 meals per day
- A shared bathroom
- An access to laundry facilities and to a phone
- Possible acces to the internet
- Possible activities with your host family

Residence

Student Residences are usually a better option for more independent students. In a residence, you share a big apartment or a house with other roommates. As no meal plan is included, you have the liberty to cook for yourself or to go to one of Montreal's little cafés or restaurants!

Each residence includes:

- A single bedroom fully furnished (including a bed with pillows and bedsheets, a towel and a desk)
- A shared fully equipped kitchen
- A shared bathroom
- A weekly cleaning service done in all common areas
- An access to laundry facilities and to a phone
- Possible acces to the internet
